We spent time at Govan War Memorial laying wreaths for Remembrance this year on the new structure that was built.



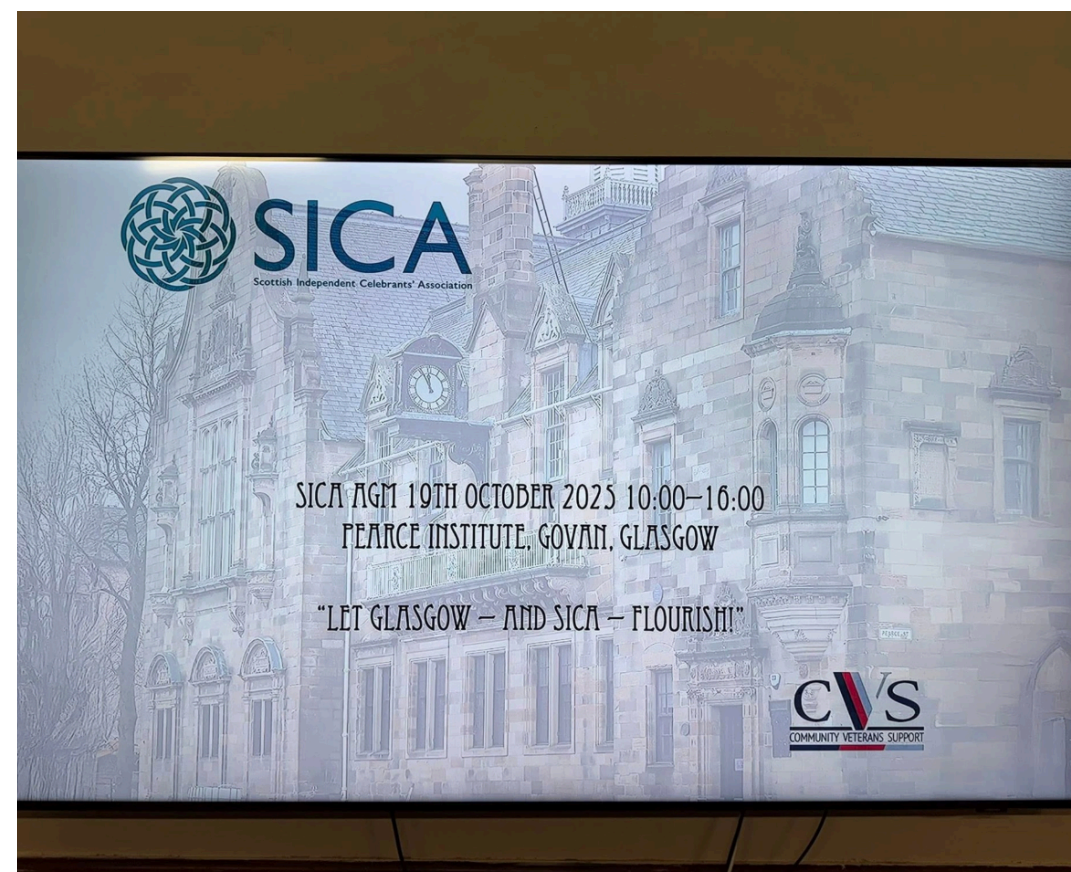
## Glasgow Garden of Remembrance
